

Mr. Nathan Zee, PMP
Deputy Program Executive Officer, Acquisition Services
Joint Medical Information Systems – Military Health System

Mr. Zee's professional career began in 1991 as an Industrial Engineer with IBM's Federal Systems Division. In 1992, he joined the Navy Nuclear Power Program and was commissioned as an Ensign in the United States Navy. He completed Naval Nuclear Power School, Nuclear Prototype Training, and the Submarine Officer Basic Course before reporting on board USS Jefferson City (SSN 759) in 1994. Mr. Zee served onboard USS Jefferson City for three years and held multiple Division Officer positions including the Strike Officer during Operation Desert Strike.



In 1997, Mr. Zee resigned his Commission as a Lieutenant and entered the full-time MBA program at Duke University where he graduated as a

Fuqua Scholar (top 10% of the class).

In 1999, Mr. Zee joined Ernst & Young's Supply Chain Management Consulting Practice. He managed and participated on various supply chain project teams including a large-scale e-transformation and ERP implementation engagement at Sprint, a supply chain transformation engagement at Discount Auto Parts, a transportation shared services engagement at Farmland Industries, and an e-Marketplace Strategic Sourcing engagement at Pennsylvania Power & Light. Mr. Zee was promoted into management after 9 months.

Mr. Zee joined RGS Associates, Inc. in 2002 as part of the Enterprise Solutions group. He managed and participated on various government consulting engagements across the Department of Navy and Department of State. Mr. Zee was promoted three times in four years and took over the Managing Director role for all Navy Headquarters business at RGS. As a management consultant, Mr. Zee focused on change management and led the RGS project teams working across multiple headquarters directorates. His focus was primarily in OPNAV N4 in the areas of Logistics IT Portfolio Management and Business Transformation.

In 2006, Mr. Zee was selected for the position of Deputy Director, Logistics Planning and Innovation (OPNAV N40) within the DCNO (Fleet Readiness & Logistics) Directorate. His responsibilities included oversight and management of activities pertaining to Navy's business transformation efforts, acquisition logistics policy, logistics strategic planning, logistics technology and innovation, and planning, programming, budgeting, and execution coordination.

In 2009, Mr. Zee transitioned to the Program Executive Office for Joint Medical Information Systems within the Military Health System. He took on the role of Deputy PEO, Acquisition Services with a focus on improving business processes associated with the acquisition of healthcare IT across DoD. He is focused on applying his military, business, and government civilian background to improving various Joint Medical and Acquisition processes.

Mr. Zee holds a Bachelor of Science in Industrial Engineering from Northwestern University and a Master of Business Administration in General Management from Duke University.
