Mr. Giesler consults for the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Intelligence; the Vice Chairman, Joint Chief of Staff; and the Deputy Director, Global Operations, Joint Staff with a focus on Information Operations and current operations. He currently serves as the Chairman, Information Operations Steering Committee for the Electronic Warfare and Information Operations Association (Old Crows).

Mr. Giesler is a graduate of the University of Maryland and the Defense Intelligence College Post-graduate Intelligence Program.
