Major Art Finch entered active duty in June 1999 as a direct commission Captain following the completion of his PhD in Clinical Psychology at Brigham Young University. His first assignment was a one-year residency program at Walter Reed Army Medical Center, followed by a three year tour in Germany as the Executive Officer for the 254th Combat Stress Control Detachment. He is currently assigned to Fort Benning, Georgia, where his primary responsibilities include psychological profiling for candidates wishing to join specialized military units, forensic psychology, and clinical treatment for soldiers and their families.
