**CURRENT ASSIGNMENTS:**

Mr. Johnson is the Director for CIP, serving within the staff of the Office of the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Homeland Defense & Americas' Security Affairs (OASD HD&ASA). CIP focuses on the identification, assessment, and mission assurance of physical and cyber assets and associated infrastructures essential to the execution of the National Military Strategy. The CIP program is aligned under the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Crisis Management & Defense Support to Civil Authorities) within the OASD (HD&ASA), which conducts and manages complex studies and analyses to establish policies and procedures to focus and upgrade military capabilities and operations to deter, prevent, and defeat threats and aggression aimed at the U.S., its territories, and interests, and if directed by the President or Secretary of Defense, provide military assistance to civil authorities, including consequence management operations.

**PAST EXPERIENCES:**

Mr. Johnson advises key DoD leadership on the relevance of current CIP capabilities, methodologies and technologies in support of military and civil homeland defense efforts. Mr. Johnson is responsible for interfacing with the Homeland Security Council, National Security Council and other federal agencies regarding the potential leveraging of DoD CIP capabilities in support of the National Strategy for Homeland Security.

Mr. Johnson's previous position was with the Defense Threat Reduction Agency as the Chief, Information Management Technology Branch/Arms Control Information and Notification (ACIN) Program Manager. In this capacity, Mr. Johnson was responsible for all information technology development supporting arms control data management reporting, advanced concepts and technology integration. His most notable accomplishment in that position involved developing and gaining acceptance of US technologies by the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe, a community of 55 participating nations. He was also responsible for developing and institutionalizing a disciplined, structured approach to acquiring IT services that serves as the "de facto" standard for DTRA IT acquisition activities. In addition, he has established several programs to respond to increasingly complex data management needs and has established and chaired numerous integrated product teams, configuration control boards and interagency working groups.

Prior to his tenure with the Defense Threat Reduction Agency, Mr. Johnson served as the Chief, Mission Systems Branch and Program Manager for the Compliance Monitoring and Tracking System (CMTS) with the On-Site Inspection Agency. In this capacity, Mr. Johnson directed the development of multiple CMTS applications to ensure U.S. compliance with notification and data exchange obligations under the Conventional Armed Forces in Europe (CFE), Intermediate Range Nuclear Forces (INF), START, START II, and Open Skies (OS) treaties; the UN Transparency in Armaments (TIA), OSCE Global Exchange of Military Information (GEMI), Wassenaar, and Confidence and Security Building Measures agreements. In this capacity, Mr. Johnson leveraged developmental activities to provide similar capability to NATO in support of active inspection planning activities under the Conventional Armed Forces in Europe treaty and Vienna Document 1999. Mr. Johnson also provided technical support to US delegations negotiating future international agreements.

From 1984 – 1994 Mr. Johnson was employed by the US Army Intelligence and Threat Analysis Center where he worked as an Operation Research Systems Analyst, responsible for development of threat methodologies, as well as modeling and simulation activities. Mr. Johnson's development of threat methodologies to normalize intelligence estimates served as the basis for deriving intelligence community estimates during Desert Storm.

Mr. Johnson has served on numerous panels, boards, special task force, IPTs, tiger teams, and community organization boards.
