

Dr. Glen H. Johnson is the Director of the State Messaging and Archival Retrieval Toolset (SMART). This project is the number one information technology project for the Department of State. It will move the Department from a "need-to-know" security architecture to a "need-to-share" environment. It will provide search technology to make its reporting broadly available. It will also deploy collaboration tools to allow better connectivity within the Department as well as the interagency. He has directed some of the most complex projects including the modernization of the U.S. Defense Export Licensing System, the Iraq Policy Transition Team, the U.S. Arms Control Data Repository, and the Y2K Task Force. Most of this work has required extensive interagency coordination. He has served as an information technology expert on delegations coordinating data and communications issues on the Chemical Weapons Convention and the Conventional Forces in Europe treaties.
