

## **Thomas F. Enright**

### **SUMMARY OF EXPERIENCE**

Thomas Enright is the Vice President of the National Security Systems Sector at SPARTA, Incorporated, a defense services company specializing in support to intelligence production, information assurance and computer network operations. Since entering the private sector, he has served as a subject matter expert in Information Operations; advising senior Defense Executives and Military Commanders on intelligence analysis, non-kinetic technology development and insertion, and effects-based operations integration.

Mr. Enright entered the private sector in 2000 following a 27 year career in the U.S. Navy. He has spearheaded support to U.S. Government Information Operations and Intelligence activities throughout the Department of Defense and the Intelligence Community. During this time he led the report on Review and Approval of Defense Department Special Access Programs and Computer Network Operations in support of Defense Planning Guidance. From 1998-2000 he served as the Deputy Assistant Director for Information Operations (J39) on the Joint Staff where he was responsible for development and execution of world-wide Information Operations programs. From 1973-1998 Mr. Enright served as a Naval Flight Officer in various Command and Staff positions including Commander, Fighter Wing Atlantic, Commander, Fighter Wing Pacific, and F-14 operational command .
