George Cybenko is the Dorothy and Walter Gramm Professor of Engineering at Dartmouth's Thayer School of Engineering in Hanover, NH.

His current research interests are in learning, modeling and detecting complex dynamical systems as they arise in computer, network and social systems.

That research is currently funded by Darpa, AFOSR, AFRL, DHS and NGA.

Cybenko was the founding Editor-in-Chief of IEEE/AIP Computing in Science and Engineering and IEEE Security & Privacy, and serves on the Board of Governors of the IEEE Computer Society and the Computing Research Association. He is a Fellow of the IEEE and a member of the Defense Science Board. He earned his B.Sc. (Toronto) and Ph.D. (Princeton) degrees in Mathematics.
