

Dr. Sujeet Shenoi

Sujeet Shenoi is the F.P. Walter Professor of Computer Science at the University of Tulsa. An active researcher with specialties in cyber security and digital forensics, Dr. Shenoi is the principal investigator on projects supported by DHS, FBI, ICE, NSA, NSF and the U.S. Secret Service. He is currently working on interesting "problems" ranging from helping solve homicides to penetrating telecommunications systems, oil and gas pipeline control (SCADA) systems, and California's voting machines. He spearheads the University of Tulsa's Cyber Corps Program, which mainly trains "MacGyvers" for the intelligence community. For his innovative strategies integrating academics, research and service, Dr. Shenoi was named the 1998-1999 U.S. Professor of the Year.
