



Carl Weiscop is the ZEIDERS ENTERPRISES, INC Navy Region Southwest Operations Supervisor and West Coast office manager. In this capacity, he is responsible for over 150 ZEIDERS employees who are supporting the Navy's Fleet and Family Support Centers at ten (10) bases in the Southwest.

Previously he was the Director of the San Diego Fleet and Family Support Center and led eighty (80) staff members in supporting over 60,000 service members and 90,000 family members in the metro San Diego area. While on active duty he earned Masters Degrees in Computer Systems Management from the Naval Postgraduate School and Human Resource Management from Chapman University.

He retired as a Captain in July 2000 and successfully transitioned to the private sector initially working for the Raytheon Corporation as Project Manager for shipboard communications systems installations; Western region operations manager for Raytheon's Information Assurance (IA) team on the NMCI contract; and business development.
