Col. Dan Bennett is an Academy Professor (Cyber Basic Branch) joining the Army Cyber Institute in 2015. He is the Chief of Research following serving a one year operational experience as the Infrastructure and Special Projects Officer for the Commander of the Cyber National Mission Force at Ft.
