Colonel Jeth B. Rey is a native of St. Thomas United States Virgin Island; he enlisted in the Army in September 1983. After completing Basic Training at Fort Dix, NJ, and Advance Individual Training at Ft Gordon, GA, he was assigned to Korea as a combat signaller. As he progressed through the enlisted ranks over the next 9 years, he served in various positions of leadership in several SPECIAL OPERATIONS UNITS at Fort Bragg, NC, and the Ranger Regiment at Fort Benning, GA.

In 1994 COL Rey graduated from the Army's Warrant Officer Candidate School (WOCS), at Fort Rucker, Alabama where he graduated as the Honor Graduate and Leadership Award winner.
