

**LTJG Marcus Guevara, USCG**Hunt and Incident Response Team

LTJG Marcus Guevara presently serves as the Team Lead of the 6th Squad of the U.S. Coast Guard Cyber (CGCYBER) Protection Team (CPT). The 6th Squad is embedded within the Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) Hunt and Incident Response Team (HIRT), a division of the National Cybersecurity and Communications Integration Center (NCCIC). LTJG Guevara and his team frequently deploy on-site to assist the DHS HIRT in Cyber Hunt and Incident Response missions that aid government and private organizations. Prior to standing up the CGCYBER CPT 6th Squad, LTJG Guevara served as a Command Duty Officer and Battle Watch Captain, representing the CGCYBER Commander before US CYBER COMMAND and Joint Force Headquarters DODIN (JFHQ-DODIN).

Prior to entering the U.S. Coast Guard, LTJG Guevara earned a Bachelor's degree in Computer Science from the University of Texas San Antonio (UTSA). He then worked as a software developer for three years before enlisting in the Texas Air National Guard. LTJG Guevara spent three years as a team lead, performing vulnerability assessments on Air Force systems undergoing accreditation. In addition, LTJG Guevara has earned a Masters of Science in Cybersecurity from the University of Maryland University College (UMUC), holds multiple certifications including CISSP, Certified Ethical Hacker (CEH), Security+, Cybersecurity Technologies Graduate Certificate and Introductory Cryptography.
