His assignments include duty as Company FSO, Battery PLT LDR, and Battery XO in 5<sup>th</sup> Battalion 41<sup>st</sup> Field Artillery/ 3<sup>rd</sup> Infantry Division in Schweinfurt Germany from 1992 to 1995; served as Battalion FSO for Rakassans, Battalion S4, and Battery Commander while assigned to 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion of the 320<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery Regiment 101<sup>st</sup> at Fort Campbell Kentucky from 1996-1999; served as the Battalion FSO for 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion 75<sup>th</sup> Ranger Regiment from 1999-2002; served as Fire Support Observer Trainer at Battle Command Training Program in Fort Leavenworth Kansas 2003-2004; after completion of CGSC served as an Operations Officer and Division Chief of Operations from 2005-2006 at the 25<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division; served as Battalion S3 and XO while assigned to 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion 11<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery Regiment 25<sup>th</sup> ID at Schofield Barracks from 2006-2008; served as FSO for United States Army Pacific Command 2007-2008; in 2009 transitioned to new functional assignment of Electronic Warfare, serving as Command EWO at USARPAC from 2009-2013; after completion of Army War College at Carlisle Barracks Pennsylvania in 2015 was assigned as III Corps Command Electronic Warfare Officer. Served in III Corps from 2015 to 2019 as the CEMA/ EW Chief and III Corps G3 Deputy at Fort Hood Texas.

Degrees include BS in Economics, MBA in Business Administration, and Masters in Strategic Studies. Combat Deployments include four to Iraq and Afghanistan.
