COL Brent Richards has served in the military for 25 years. He received his commission as a Distinguished Military Graduate from the Indiana University ROTC program in 1992 and began his career as an Infantry Platoon

Leader and Executive Officer with the 1-187th Rakkasans, 101St Airborne Division (AASLT). Throughout his military career, he has held various leadership positions including, Company Commander, Battalion and Brigade Intelligence Officer (S2), Division Senior Intelligence Officer (G2), Battalion Commander, Joint Force Headquarters Deputy Operations Officer (J3), Brigade Executive Officer, Chief of Strategic Plans and Business Transformation (J5), Senior Intelligence Officer (J2), and is currently serving as the Army National Guard Senior Intelligence Officer (G2) and Chief Information Officer (G6).

COL Richards' military education includes Infantry Officer Basic Course, Airborne School, Air Assault School, Ranger School, Armor Officer Advanced Course, Military Intelligence Transition Course, Combined Arms Staff and Service School, Command and General Staff College- Intermediate Level Education, Military Intelligence Pre-Command Course, and Army War College.

COL Richards holds a Bachelor of Science and a Masters of Public Affairs from Indiana University and a Master of Strategic Studies from the Army War College.

COL Richards has served in two deployments in Afghanistan. The first with the 76th Infantry Brigade Combat Team as part of Task Force Phoenix from May 2004 to October 2005 where he served as the Combined Joint Task Force J2. The second was with the 38th Infantry Division as part of Task Force Cyclone from August 2009 to July 2010 where he served as the Assistant Chief of Staff and the Task Force Senior Intelligence Officer (G2).
