Other significant assignments include Commanding General, U.S. Army Intelligence Center; C2 (Director of Intelligence), Combined Joint Task Force-7 and Multi-National Forces-Iraq; J2 (Director of Intelligence), U.S. European Command; Associate Deputy Director of Operations/Deputy Chief, Central Security Service and S1, National Security Agency; Commander, 66th Military Intelligence Group; G2 (Director of Intelligence), 2nd Armored Division; Commander, 163rd Military Intelligence Battalion. She received numerous U.S. and foreign awards and decorations, including the Defense Superior Service Medal with one Oak Leaf Cluster, Legion of Merit, and Bronze Star Medal.

She is a member of a variety of boards and advisory groups, to include: American Public Education, Incorporated; the National Military Intelligence Association; the Armed Forces Communications and Electronics Association Cyber Committee; and the Intelligence and National Security Alliance.

She holds a Master of Science degree in business administration from Boston University, a Bachelor of Science degree in education (German, Spanish) from the University of Missouri, and an honorary Doctorate of Law degree from Central Missouri State University. She is also a graduate of the U.S. Army War College, the Armed Forces Staff College, and the Military Intelligence Officer Basic and Advanced Courses.
