Mr. Brian E. Hack is a former Executive Leader at the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA). Prior to retirement, Brian served as the Deputy Chief Information Officer (CIO) and Deputy Director Information Technology Enterprise (ITE) at CIA where he led the development, delivery, and modernization of key systems, networks, Cyber Security, and policies essential in the delivery of intelligence throughout the Intelligence Community (IC) and United States Government. He had a distinguished 37-year career supporting the CIA, National Reconnaissance Office (NRO), and broader IC missions. He held multiple senior leadership positions across the Directorate of Digital Innovation, Directorate of Science & Technology, and the National Reconnaissance Office where he led the acquisition and delivery of multiple mission critical systems. Brian was instrumental in crafting the Acquisition, Workforce/talent, and CIA C-Suite strategies focused on emerging technologies, cloud migration, and enhanced Cyber Security. He served as the executive sponsor for the CIA's multi-cloud acquisition that supports the broader IC.

Brian was awarded the Distinguished Career Intelligence Medal (DCIM) by the CIA in recognition of his exceptional leadership, dedication, exemplary service, and significant contributions to the mission.

Since retirement, Brian founded Digital Hack Consulting LLC to advise, promote, and build key partnerships between government and industry to solve hard problems and meet mission objectives. He serves on the Advisory Boards of GitLab federal, Craxel, and the Cyber Security Forum Initiative (CSFI).
