Mr. Jared Evans currently serves as the Director of the Transition Acceleration Program at the Office of Strategic Capital. In that role, he served as the lead program manager for the Open Topic and Strategic Funding (STRATFI) programs and helped manage \$1.8B of combined government funding and private capital for scaling early to mid-stage technology ventures to support Air Force operations. Mr. Evans continues to serve in the Air Force Reserves.
