



Dr. Victor Piotrowski is a Lead Program Director at the National Science Foundation (NSF), an independent U.S. Federal Agency reporting directly to the Executive Office of the President. For the last 16 years, Dr. Piotrowski has been leading a \$74 million CyberCorps® SFS program to increase the number of qualified students entering the field of cybersecurity, and to increase the capacity of the United States education enterprise to produce professionals in this field. He is currently working on translating cybersecurity education and workforce frameworks to Artificial Intelligence.

Dr. Piotrowski is a graduate of the Federal Executive Institute and the Harvard Kennedy School Executive Education Cybersecurity Policy and Technology program. He is also a recipient of the 2015 Founder's Award by the Colloquium for Information Systems Security Education. In 2017, he worked as a U.S. Embassy Science Fellow in Cybersecurity with activities in Baltic and Nordic countries. Before coming to NSF, Dr. Piotrowski served as a Professor and Chair of the Computer Science Department at the University of Wisconsin.
